- 1. Virtues: a good habit that helps us to act according to God's love for us
- 2. Faith: the virtue that enables us to believe in God and all that the Church teaches us; it helps us to believe all that God has told us about Himself and all that He has done
- 3. Hope: the virtue that enables us to trust in God's promise to share his life with us forever; it makes us confident in God's love and care for us
- 4. Love: the greatest of all virtues that enables us to love God and to love our neighbor
- 5. Priesthood of the Faithful: Christ's priestly mission in which all those who are baptized share
- 6. Laypeople: all the baptized members of the Church who share in the mission to bring the Good News of Christ to the world
- 7. Religious: women and men who belong to communities of service to God and the Church
- 8. Matrimony: the sacrament in which a man and woman become husband and wife and promise to be faithful to each other for the rest of their lives
- 9. Marriage Covenant: the life-long commitment between a man and woman to live as faithful and loving partners
- 10. Fidelity: faithfulness to a person and to duties, obligations, and promises; in marriage, the loyalty and the willingness to be true to each other always
- 11. Holy Orders: the sacrament in which baptized men are ordained to serve the Church as deacons, priests, and bishops
- 12. Bishops: the successors of the Apostles who are ordained to continue the Apostles' mission of leadership and service in the Church
- 13. Priests: ordained ministers who serve the Christian faithful by leading, ,teaching, and most especially celebrating the Eucharist and other sacraments
- 14. Deacons: baptized men who are not priests but are ordained to the work of service for the Church
- 15. Ecumenism: the work to promote unity among all Christians
- 16. Stewards of Creation: those who take care of everything that God has given them
